MGL Cargo Services are pleased to report on two recent shipments which travelled internationally, involving large units of cargo.

The first shipment originated from Shanghai, China and included the transport of sixteen SHACMAN trucks.

Delivered to Toamasina Port in Madagascar, MGL Cargo Services covered vessel chartering, loading (including lashing & welding), as well as discharging.

- SHACMAN F3000 6x4 Dump Truck (x13) 1.
- SHACMAN F3000 6x4 Sprinkler Truck (x2) 2.
- 3. SHACMAN F3000 4x2 Oil Tanker Truck (x1)

The company's second shipment concerned the transit of an overhead crane girder, which measured 18.5 meters long with a weight of five tons.

Originating from Alexandria in Egypt, MGL Cargo Services oversaw the successful transport to Skikda, Algeria by arranging pre-carriage, customs clearance, lashing, and documentation.

The consignment included **two cold boxes** with dimensions of **62.7 (L) x 6.56 (W) x 6.60 (H) meters**, with a weight of **232.5 metric tons** each.

Additionally, EXG transported one heat exchanger, alongside other key cargo components.

For this journey, the company utilised various advanced equipment:

- **Hydraulic Axles**: A configuration of 28 axles were employed to distribute the weight of the cargo evenly and ensure stable transportation.
- **SPMTs**: 24 axles were used to maneuver the cargo efficiently through the route's various challenges.

The route covered a significant distance from **Hazira Port** to the designated site, requiring meticulous coordination and preparation. "During this project, our team undertook essential civil work to guarantee the safe and smooth passage of these oversized packages."

EXG preemptively addressed **road conditions** by filling potholes, ensuring a smooth and **damage-free transit** for the heavy cargo.

To accommodate the **dimensions of the cargo**, they worked with local authorities to **temporarily dismantle** electrical wiring, camera poles, and navigation boards, safeguarding both the infrastructure and the cargo.

The team promptly **reinstalled all dismantled elements** after the cargo had passed, minimising disruptions to the local area.

Ceekay Shipping Services were recently involved in the end-to-end multimodal logistics for the movement of a geo-thermal rig and it's accessories to the Philippines. The cargo totalled **144** pieces of various sizes and shapes at **7,000cbm** carried on **85** trucks. The project was meticulously planned and executed with pinpoint precision so that all the set timelines were met leading to a happy and satisfied client.

The rig was crated and seaworthy packed by the Ceekay inhouse rig packing team who relocated to Oman for the project for a period of 25 days. The rig packing list creation and packaging was done in the presence of the shipper appointed Marine Warranty Surveyors.

The shipment was executed with 85 trucks loaded at Nizwa and Muscat and moved to a intermediate storage yard in the Sohar Port area to counter the Strategic Partnerships: Collaborating with reliable shortage of storage space in the shippers vard. Once partners facilitated smooth operations and minimized the paperwork, documentation and customs clearance potential disruptions. was completed, the full lot was moved from the storage yard to Sohar Port with no issues thanks to Customs Compliance: Adhering to customs the supervision and expertise of the Ceekay team. It regulations and documentation requirements in both was then loaded to the chartered heavy lift vessel for Oman and the Philippines ensured smooth clearance shipping to the Philippines. processes and avoided delays.
