## CUCHI SHIPPING TRANSPORT RISER CATWALK TO LOUISIANA

**Cuchi Shipping**, our members from **Vietnam**, are glad to share a recently completed project in October involving a **Riser Catwalk** from **Vung Tau**.

The modular catwalk featured dimensions of **31.01 x 2.67 x 2.28 meters**, with a weight of **38,102 kilograms**.

The cargo was received locally from a factory in Vung Tau, before being moved to **Bason, Phu My Por**t for direct loading onto a vessel, where it travelled to **New Iberia, Louisiana**.

Cuchi Shipping was established in the '90's with their Head Office located in Hochiminh City, and branch offices across Vietnam. Their facilities include warehouse (bonded and CFS), prime movers, hydraulic trailers, low-bed trailers, barges, tug-boats, tractors, trailers, trucks and vans.



### EXG COMPLETES BREAKBULK MOVEMENT OF PIPES TO BANGLADESH

**Express Global Logistics** are pleased to share a report on their latest breakbulk movement involving large pipes from **Southeast Asia** to **Bangladesh**.

The transport consisted of 72 large pipes, with a combined weight of 3,400 metric tons and a total freight volume of 6,100 cubic meters.

This impressive project involved meticulous planning and execution, divided into two strategic lots to ensure safe, efficient handling and delivery of the cargo.

#### **Project Overview**

Given the sheer volume and dimensions of the cargo, devised an optimal plan to transport the shipment in two distinct lots.

The division of the shipment into two lots allowed for more streamlined handling, facilitating timely loading and transportation across international waters to Bangladesh.

#### Expert Planning and Seamless Execution

EXG's breakbulk desk ensured that the loading operations were not only safe but also conducted with precision, despite the large dimensions and weights of the pipes.

EXG demonstrated its operational flexibility, which

allowed for optimised resource management and risk mitigation.

This method also facilitated greater control over cargo movements, leading to safe, timely delivery despite the challenges of handling such a large and heavy load.

#### Safe Loading and Efficient Execution

EXG's operations team coordinated the cargo loading onto breakbulk vessels, ensuring safety protocols to prevent any damage or delays.

By ensuring a high standard of planning and on-theground execution, the team completed the process efficiently, maintaining a steady workflow throughout.

Minimising Downtime

This level of precision highlights EXG's commitment to operational excellence and client satisfaction.

#### 1. Uncertainty at POD

Issue: During the second lot's transportation, there was a period of unrest at the POD , which created an uncertain environment.

This situation posed potential challenges for timely delivery and required careful planning to navigate disruptions in key transportation routes

Despite the difficult circumstances, EXG's team maintained close coordination and monitored the situation constantly.

By strategically planning and adjusting routes, the team ensured the cargo was delivered safely and without delays, staying true to EXG's commitment to its clients.

#### 2. Heavy Rainfall During Transport

Adverse weather conditions, particularly heavy rain, posed significant ring the inland transportation phase.





The team relied on weather forecasts to plan the optimal timing for vehicle movements, ensuring that operations proceeded during more favorable conditions.

Despite the heavy rainfall, EXG carefully coordinated the transport to avoid delays, further demonstrating its operational efficiency and attention to detail in unpredictable weather scenarios.

### 3. Civil Work

EXG carried out minor civil work during transit to ensure the smooth passage of the cargo.

### KGE NOMINATED FOR MULTIMODAL PROJECT TRANSPORT TO AL-ULA

KGE are pleased to share an interesting multimodal project which they recently completed from Switzerland to Saudi Arabia.

This transport involved **four traverse beams**, which were delivered through air freight and land transport **across 5 days** (including transit clearance).

The cargo featured dimensions of 7.06 x 1.42 x 1.93 metres each, with weights of 4,590 kilograms.

These beams were transported using two open top trucks from **Switzerland** to **Frankfurt Airport** in **Germany**, where they went through inspection and other procedures before proceeding with air freight.

Once cleared for take-off, the traverse beams flew to King Khalid International Airport in **Riyadh**, where they were collected and subsequently transported by truck until arrival in **AI-UIa**.

"We complete approximately 15% of our air cargo movements via multimodal transport."

**SABER import customs** were required in Riyadh before the cargo arrived via QAR, so the company had to plan their transportation accordingly due to a client's request that the transport be made **within 3-5 days**.

KGE provided their customer with **complete daily tracking** and monitored the entire shipment, resulting in satisfied customer feedback.



### **MEGAGON COMPLETE MOVEMENT OF TRANSFORMER TO KLAIPEDA**

Megagon Project Solutions are glad to share the recent movement of a transformer and its accessories, as well as completed shipments throughout the year.

Originating from Balikesir, Turkiye, Megagon collected the 110-ton transformer and its accessories before onward transport to Klaipedia, Lithuania.

This shipment consisted of 25 units with a volume of 198 cbm, and a total weight of 126 tons.

### UPCARGO NAVIGATE DAILY CHALLENGES IN OVERSIZED CARGO LOGISTICS

**UPCARGO Logistics**, our members from **Panama**, are pleased to report on some of the challenges faced in their logistics chain during a **recent shipment**.

Recently, the company encountered a **significant disruption** due to a change in their **Port of Destination**.

Originally, the route was set from the **Port of Shanghai** to the **Port of Balboa**.

However, the flat racks ended up at the **Port of Manzanillo, Colon**, approximately **80 kilometers** away from Balboa.

The company only learned a day after arrival that the cargo would remain at the Manzanillo Terminal.

This change resulted in several challenges, including increased transportation costs for the client, extra costs for road adjustments, as well as additional route studies.

#### Scope of Work

- Reception at the port
- Port survey
- Unloading of 2 x 40' flat racks and 1 x 20' flat rack
- Transport using lowboys
- Police escort
- Route study
- Nighttime transport
- Customs custody

UPCARGO Logistics conducted thorough studies and route evaluations from the Balboa Terminal to the delivery point, just 40 kilometers away, with exceptional results.

#### **Challenges Faced with this POD Change**

**1. Longer Travel Distance:** This increase meant more potential obstacles. During a route study, UPCARGO identified that they would not pass one of the toll booths on the northern corridor. Their solution was to remove some jerseys that defined the roadway to avoid the toll.

**2. Adjustments with Time Constraints:** While the company have requested such adjustments in the past, this time was different due to tight delivery schedules. Involving multiple suppliers meant that any delay could result in additional costs, with the primary goal to minimise these expenses for their clients.

**3. Rapid Permitting:** In record time, UPCARGO obtained the necessary permits and costs to remove the jerseys, secured an assignment from a traffic police unit, and managed operations at the port.

**4. Proactive Measures:** Anticipating this situation, they took steps in advance by scheduling port appointments and inspections.

**5.** Successful Execution: In the end, the company successfully removed the cargo from the terminal without any issues.

This shipment involved **15 units** of equipment which were transported across **22 containers**, including 10 x 40' flat racks, 11 x 40' open tops and a single 20' general purpose container.

After removal from the mining site, the cargo was loaded in **Cagayan de Oro Port** before travelling to **Jebel Ali Port** in **Dubai**.

Nonpareil International covered a wide scope of work for this project, such as:

- Road & site survey
- Destruction & reconstruction of overhead/road obstruction
- Mobilisation from mining site to staging area using articulated trailers
- Disassembly of units
- Cutting of over-length parts
- Loading, lashing, shoring, welding & washing
- Issuance of certificate of lashing
- Surveyor report

For a **cost-effective and efficient process** for their client, the equipment was loaded & shipped out as CKD (complete knock down) using **flat racks, open-top containers**, and **standard containers**, instead of shipping via chartered vessel or RO/RO service.

A road and site survey was conducted to ensure that the project could be transported and executed despite **road site obstructions**, whilst complying with current regulations & standards.

This **499-ton job** was transferred from the mining site using **articulated trailers**, including vessel bridges, low loaders, as well as lowbed & flatbed trailers.

The cargo was then **transferred using cranes** to individual containers before onward delivery to the final destination.
