BUSINESS E-MAIL COMPROMISE (BEC) SCAM

We would like to remind Members to be aware and extra cautious of Business E-Mail Compromise (BEC), the sophisticated scam whereby criminals compromise legitimate business e-mail accounts through social engineering or computer intrusion techniques to conduct unauthorized transfers of funds, normally into a 'new' bank account.

WHO IS LIABLE?

We understand the frustration involved if a company becomes a victim and that huge losses can be suffered, which can cause arguments regarding who is liable. Personally, I feel the banks should be taking more responsibility, or at least they should be working harder to prevent these cases.

However, the company who fell victim should consider itself liable for the damage as it has (albeit unknowingly) transferred and authorised the payment of funds to the criminals. Therefore, the company who transferred the money is liable for the loss.

It is extremely important to ensure that



your business insurance policy covers BEC scams, including other potential hacking and phishing scams.

TAKE ACTION TODAY.

We urge Members to be extra cautious when transferring funds and if you are informed that the bank details of a company has changed, please telephone the management of the company for clarification.

The PCN Head Office suggests that you review your payment procedures and ensure you have verification steps in place to monitor payments. If it is a considerable sum, you could send a small amount first and then check they have received it before paying the balance. Unfortunately, as much as we would like to assist, the PCN Head Office is powerless over these scams and any cases must be reported immediately to the police as it is a criminal matter.

Finally, please check that the online security of your systems is at the maximum, including updated firewall and anti-virus software.



The engine had dimensions of 9.70 x 2.20 x 3.65m as photographed in the gallery below. Muhammad Kamran explains: "The movement of the engine from Port Qasim to the Korangi Industrial Area in Karachi was a challenging job. Due to the over-dimensions and heavy weight of the cargo, the transportation through Karachi City required great skill being one of the most urban city areas of Pakistan with very heavy traffic and low-height bridges. Road clearance permissions and non-scheduled electric shutdowns were taken in order to deliver the OOG engine to the Yunus Brothers site. On arrival, the unloading was successfully and safely performed by a jacking/skidding method (as pictured) to avoid the involvement of heavy-duty cranes and extra charges."

- To highlight measures that can lead to peaceful coexistence in IOR.



Project #1: Fish Tank from Italy to Aquarium Site

Polaris' first project included a job to position a fish tank in an aquarium hall, which was approximately 12 m from ground level.

The fish tank weighed approximately 68 MT and featured dimensions of 7.9 \times 6.9 \times 4.6 m.

The scope of the job included tilting the fish tank prior to its placement at the proposed platform.

This specific operation was successfully handled via tandem lift, using two mobile cranes (1 \times 160 MT & 1 \times 400 MT).

The transportation job for the tank from Italy to the project site site was also earlier coordinated by the Polaris Project team.

Furthermore, Polaris' scope of operations also covered necessary site adjustments, technical evaluations, preparation of needed drawings for the approval of all concerned which was carried to the full satisfaction of all.

Project #2: Industrial Equipment

Polaris Shipping also completed the demobilisation of equipment from Al Reem Island, Abu Dhabi to Alexandria, Egypt in December.

The shipment included Soilmec Rigs, Sany Mobile Cranes and other industrial equipment which were suitably dismantled for the base unit to be shipped as RO-RO with accessories in special purpose containers.

Polaris has their professional in-house dismantle all sorts of construction equipment – loading/lashing and securing on special purpose containers or suitable break-bulk/ RO-RO vessels as the case may be.



COORDINADORA WITH COMPLEX PROJECT FROM SPAIN TO SAUDI ARABIA

Coordinadora has been working for over a year on a demanding project that has demonstrated their capabilities and their 'ETM' methodology:

"ETM (Engineered Transport Management) is a methodology where the entire process of a project cargo transport planning and operation is analysed, calculated, developed and managed applying engineering techniques and processes."

After managing several airfreight transport operations for this project, at the beginning of May, Coordinadora began the transport process of the heaviest pieces entrusted to them: 5 slug gas catchers weighing 2,008 t each.

These pieces were transported from Gijón, Spain to Jubail, KSA. They were carried in 2 shipments, both following the same transportation plan: after travelling approximately one month by sea, they were to be unloaded and carried 95 km by SPMT to Fadhili facilities.

Coordinadora is managing the entire transportation process, making sure every detail is taken care of and subcontracting every supplier. They also followed all stages of the operation on site, requiring the relocation of their team to the port

transportation up to the plant premises.

The challenges faced by Coordinadora included:

- Finding a vessel that met the needs of this project suitable for ro-ro loading
- Precise calculations of the mooring arrangement, considering the constraints existing at both ports, origin and destination
- Manufacturing grillage, designed in-house by their specialised engineers and installed in what they considered to be recordbreaking speed
- A special and innovative sea-fastening solution had to be developed due to cargo limitations - the solution consisted of a unique combination of lashing and structural bracing

Due to the complexity of the operation, Coordinadora calculated the detailed ballasting procedure for loading and unloading of the cargo on the vessel

Tera experienced some obstacles during the journey such as traffic due peak hours, narrow turning roads, and highway tolls, but they managed to overcome the difficulties with their escort and professional team which were well trained for handling such circumstances and oversize cargo at anywhere and anytime. Cargo was sent for direct loading.

2. Deaerator Tank - Storage Tank & Accessories

- Dimensions: 18 x 5.1 x 9.9 m (x2)

Scope of Work: First, Tera Shipping collected the said units from client's premises and delivered them to Westports, Port Klang. Tera then utilised a two-unit multi-axle trailer and a one-unit crane to load both the Deaerator and storage tank with the accessories in accordance to its dimension and weight.

Tera Shipping faced challenges on delivery as there were hurdles of power and communication cables. After all formalities were completed with the authorities, Tera were permitted entry to the Port and subsequently the loaded trailers were escorted by the Port Police through container zones until they reached the nominated wharf of conventional zone.

The Captain at the Port refused to load the Storage Tank and steel plate together, which was already fixed to the bottom of the cargo and requested that they remove prior to loading the vessel.

Tera's logistics team immediately removed the steel plates from the bottom of the cargo after liaison with concerned parties and replaced with wooden blocks in order to avoid the damaging the nozzle of the cargo during loading.

C.H. ROBINSON ENABLE URGENT AIR SHIPMENT TO CHINA

A C.H. Robinson customer in the automotive industry needed to ship machinery to Orlando, Florida, and from there to Liuzhou, Guangxi, China.

Due to this being a last-minute request, however, their regular crating company in Michigan was unable to complete the job in time.

That's when the company contacted the C.H. Robinson project logistics team to find alternatives.

C.H. Robinson's team has a long-time relationship with the company, as well as with craters in the Chicago area. The team arranged for crating to take place the following day.

As the crating was underway, the company awarded the transport portion to the team; the urgently needed freight would need to be shipped by air.

Thirteen crates totaling 166 cubic meters and 44.6 metric tons were transported for the company, with the largest piece measuring 5.69 x 2.36 x 2.36 meters and weighing 14 metric tons.

Cranes were used to load the crates onto the aircraft for transport from O'Hare in Chicago through South Korea to Guangzhou Baiyun International Airport in China.

From there, they were transported inland to the customer's door in Liuzhou, Guangxi, China.

"The company was impressed with the C.H. Robinson project logistics team's knowledge, flexibility, and connections to find out-of-the-box solutions and deliver the cargo safely and quickly."



C.H. ROBINSON OVERSEE U.S. WIND FARM DELIVERIES

The C.H. Robinson project logistics team was kept busy in 2018, delivering components for six new wind farms in the U.S.

Over the course of 23 weeks, C.H. Robinson delivered 176 wind turbines utilising 1,544 truckloads.

The volume totaled 579,670 cbm and consisted of 51,320 MT of blades, towers, nacelles (machine heads), and hubs.

C.H. Robinson's experienced team of experts was deft at dealing with the multiple origins and their skilled project managers were on-site dealing with any upcoming issues. Road construction occurred without warning along some routes, requiring the C.H. Robinson team to update their existing permits.

On-going truck and driver shortages continued to be problematic, but thanks to strong relationships within the industry, C.H. Robinson mitigated any delays.

At times, bad weather produced poor site conditions and made deliveries to these remote locations difficult. However, their experienced on-site project managers were able to continue to execute deliveries even during times of heavy rainfall.

C.H. ROBINSON WITH MASS COOLER SHIPMENT TO AUSTRALIA

In 2018, a customer approached the C.H. Robinson project logistics team about a project that required moving 34 coolers – each weighing between 10,000 and 12,000 pounds – from the United States to Australia. Getting the job done took careful coordination by several offices on two continents.



Any project of this size would require careful planning, but this one came with an additional challenge of planning for multiple origins and destinations.

Starting in either New York or Baltimore, 28 coolers shipped to the Port of Kembla in Sydney for final delivery to Eastern Creek, New South Wales.

The remaining six coolers shipped to the Port of Melbourne for delivery to Deer Park, Victoria.

It took six ocean shipments and a combination of over-dimensional flat-rack and rolling on and off the vessel (RORO) to make it happen.

All totaled, the project's total weight and volume was 355,000 pounds and 2,036 cubic meters.

With so many ocean shipments moving at once, experts kept close track of all the project's moving parts.

This dedication, combined with proactive communication with the customer helped all 34 coolers arrive in good order.

C.H. ROBINSON WITH SUCCESSFUL RAIL SHIPMENTS ACROSS THE UNITED STATES

TTX

C.H. Robinson was contacted by their client to determine the shipping method for moving 219 marine pilings across the United States.

Although the company had shipped pilings over the road in the past, given the volume, weight, length, and cross country lane, their project logistics experts advised transporting by rail.

C.H. Robinson was able to provide a better option and a competitive solution that helped the company win the business.

The marine pilings were required at two marine terminals - in Port Hueneme, California, and Benicia, California – to upgrade piers.

Scope was from free on rail origin in Winchester, VA to free on rail destination; 7 rail cars to the Port Hueneme, CA and 2 rail cars to Benicia, CA. Each destination was around 4,300 kilometers (2,672 miles) away.

The rail cars were loaded according to the team's drawings and specifications, based on carrier requirements.

There were a couple instances where the rail cars were humped at interchanges – which is a normal practice whereby cars are pushed up an incline and then rolled to the appropriate track – causing some of the cargo to shift.

C.H. Robinson worked closely with the railroads to not only re-secure the shifted loads but to prevent further loads from being humped.

The 219 marine pilings measured 75' x 1'4" x 1'4" each and had a total weight of 565 metric tons and a total volume of 768 cubic meters. They were all safely delivered to their destinations.

This initiative was chosen for our 2018 fundraising as it is close to the heart of PCN President/CEO, Rachel Humphrey, who's youngest son, George was diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes in October 2010 at the age of 10. Rachel says: "Paula and EDPD are carrying out fantastic work in raising awareness of type 1 diabetes in Costa Rica. As well as helping people to understand the condition, it is also important that they can continue to spread general awareness of the symptoms. Undiagnosed type 1 diabetes can be fatal – around 1 in 4 people that are diagnosed receive their diagnosis after a very dangerous condition called diabetic ketoacidosis has developed, which can become life threatening if it is not treated immediately." Additionally, Gavin Griffiths 'Diathlete' from England helped give out PCN bags to children during a camp called "growing together" where he provided education in diabetes through games and activities. 



Sadleirs organised the move on an ASCL vessel with dual 60 MT cranes.


Their planning and execution had to be changed at the last minute due to another unrelated vessel, berthed nearby, suffering an oil spillage in Fremantle Harbour.

The disruption caused by the subsequent clean-up process meant we had to move the reel along the wharf face to the re-assigned berth for the ASCL vessel.

The planning change scope of work involved port handling, OOG transport and wharf stevedore co-ordination.

Both of the vessel's cranes were used to perform a 'dual' lift to stow the reel on deck. The entire movement was carried out effectively and efficiently, even with the forced change of plans, with no delays to the transit.

ATLAS WITH EXECUTION OF TWO MAJOR PROJECTS

Project #1: November, 2018

In November 2018, ATLAS exported a salt melting furnace and its accessories from Shuaiba Port in Kuwait to Valencia, Spain for their client Herlogas.

The job had to be completed within a week due to the impending expiry of the temporary bond obtained from the Kuwait customs.

ATLAS' scope of work was to move the complete cargo (dimensions of 5.3 x 4.4 x 4.1 m and weight of 27 MT) and equipment by sea.

Since this was an ODC, ATLAS had to arrange their own equipment to cross load the container.

The furnace was of sensitive material and ATLAS couldn't directly expose it to metal chains, so they hired a third-party to make cushions for them which were used before lashing the cargo in during transit from Dubai.

Project #2: December, 2018

In December 2018, ATLAS exported prefabricated building structures and glass wool insulation materials for multiple clients, including Kimmco-Isover and Kirby Building Systems.

The first set of dimensions for ATLAS' first export were standard trucks (12 meter side walled) and standard dry containers with cargo weighing between 12 to 24 tons. For their second client it was standard trucks (12 meter side walled) and standard dry containers with cargo weight ranging between 4 to 12 tons.

The mode of transportation used was a combination of sea and land. By road the origin was Kuwait and the destination was GCC & Levant Areas. By sea, origin remained the same but the destination was Qatar, Yemen, Africa, Cyprus & Pakistan etc.

All the problems and delays were handled by ATLAS by preplanning container bookings with various shipping lines as per the destination requirement of client.

ATLAS coordinated with the transportation department to have the required number of trucks on standby. ATLAS also had round-theclock operations coordination with the loading team at the factory to make sure export customs documents were issued accurately.

The cargo was moved from Korea and Japan to Uzbekistan via Mersin.

The shipment contained several equipment and pipes for a power plant which located in Uzbekistan.

Goods were loaded in Korea & Japan partially, but transshipment took place as a single party, directly to the consignee.

Origin managed the un-lashing, transferring to the trucks of the products and then lashing & dunnage processes.

Furthermore, they fully provided the transit custom formalities.
