KHIMJI RAMDAS EXPORT 1500 HP RIG FROM OMAN TO PHILIPPINES

Khimji Ramdas Shipping, our members from Oman, recently executed the multimodal shipment of a 1500 HP geothermal rig and its accessories.

The shipment consisted of a total of **144 pieces** and a **total volume of 7,000 cbm**. **85 trailer-loads** of varying sizes and shapes were utilised for transport.

Khimji Ramdas Shipping took charge of all operations in Oman, including

- Marine warranty surveyor arrangements
- Route survey for the OD cargoes
- Packing list preparations
- Segregation & labelling
- Customs clearance
- Port handling
- Cargo sorting
- Loading
- Haulage

The geothermal rig was **crated and packed** to be seaworthy by Khimji Ramdas' professional packing partner team, who were **relocated to Oman** for this specific project **over twenty-five days**.

"Marine warranty surveyors were appointed and observed the creation of the rig packing list & packaging process."

The shipment was executed with a plan to move 85 truck loads **from Nizwa and Muscat** to a storage yard in the area of **Sohar Port**. This was to counter the shortage of storage space in the shipper's yard.

In execution of the haulage, the team had to negotiate a number of challenges, with the major one being preparation of **customs documentation** and the **packing list**.

The geothermal rig was also **refurbished in Oman** with cargoes featuring **multiple countries of origin**. Customs declarations were required to be made separately for the Oman and non-Oman made cargoes.

Khimji Ramdas' customs documentation team worked with the shipper and **identified each cargoes' origin** to solve this challenge successfully.

Due to the **fully-assembled condition** of the rig, it **required dismantling** and proposed another challenge as this was not a known fact to the shipper.

Khimji Ramdas employed the services of a **professional surveyor** to measure the **dimensions & weight** of each piece to overcome this challenge.





TRANSNETWORK AFRICAN FREIGHT DELIVERS CRANE TO INHAMBANE

Transnetwork African Freight are glad to announce they recently & successfully transported a shipment from **Durban** to **Temane, Inhambane**.

The company used trucks to move a **four-hundred ton crane** and its **counterweights**.

- A lowbed carried a **19-metre long** section of the crane which weighed **90 tons**.
- 5 superlinks and 1 semi carried up to 140 tons of counterweights & ancilliary equipment.
- A step deck for the guying frame.

"We temporarily exported it, and after 90 days we will re-import it back to South Africa."

This shipment was collected from the **Durban South Africa 1C Baltex Road Prospection**. Its drop point was in **Temane, Inhambane** at one of Sasol's sites.

The main pieces of cargo for this shipment involved four tanks, accompanied by thirty-one packages weighing **28,200 kilograms**.

Additionally, 650 big bags were delivered for a total of 845 MT.



3P LOGISTICS EXECUTE DELIVERY OF STAMPING PRESS TO POLAND

3p Logistics Industrial Projects have successfully delivered a **stamping press** from the **Port of Hamburg, Germany** to **Skawina, Poland**.

This transport consisted of four trucks, one set and **eleven packages** for a total of **97 tons**. The trip took around **900 kilometres by road**.

3p Logistics reported the heaviest piece of cargo at 65 tons, whilst the total weight of the heaviest-loaded truck was 125 tons.

Ilya Goncharov, the project manager responsible for this job, offered his comments:


"Whilst in Europe, we used a special lowbed modular trailer with eight axles, plus a truck with four. This project required a route survey, bridge conclusions as well as a police escort."

Preparations required **almost five months** from first touches to the final destination. It took **3 weeks** to acquire a permit for the sixty-five tons of cargo in Germany, and around **5 weeks for Poland**.

"It seems the Germany heavy transport crisis has ended!"

The stamping press will be used to produce new supplies for the **automotive industry** in Poland.





EXG MOVE TUNNEL BORING MACHINES FOR PATNA METRO RAIL PROJECTS

EXG have once again set new standards with the completion of lowering two **Tunnel Boring Machines** (TBMs) into the launching shafts for the **Patna Metro Rail Projects**.

These massive TBMs, each weighing up to **450 MT**, play a crucial role in excavating tunnels for the underground metro station.

The first TBM was descended smoothly by EXG at **Moin UI Haq** underground metro station, followed by the second at **Gandhi Maidan** underground metro station.

Navigating Challenges with Expertise

Handling such heavy machinery was no small feat. The TBMs arrived in dismantled parts and were meticulously assembled by EXG's expert team.

EXG devised a smart solution to tackle space constraints and a congested area, which rendered crane use unfeasible for handling such heavy cargo..



JSL GLOBAL HANDLE TELESCOPIC SUCTION PIPE FROM BAHRAIN TO QATAR

JSL Global are pleased to report on the successful delivery of a **telescopic suction pipe** which required meticulous planning & coordination.

With dimensions of 21.0 (L) x 2.05 (W) x 2.40 (H) meters and a weight of 10,614 kg, the cargo posed challenges due to its size and weight, necessitating special equipment and careful handling.

The project involved transporting the cargo from **Bahrain to Doha, Qatar, via Saudi Arabia**, by road freight.

This was actioned for a prominent alumina refinery company in Doha, located in one of the industrial cities in Qatar. The cargo was **vital for their plant operations**, demanding adherence to strict timelines.

Specialised trailers - including a long trailer of twentytwo meters for cross-country shipment - were utilised, followed by another long trailer for in-country movement to the client's site. Challenges arose during the transportation process, notably obtaining permits for the **Bahrain Causeway** and undergoing X-ray scanning at the KSA border due to the cargo's length.

To meet the client's time-sensitive requirements, thorough planning was essential. **Gate passes, escort approvals**, and **cross-loading plans** were arranged precisely to ensure seamless movement and adherence to deadlines.

"Despite the logistical hurdles, collaborative efforts and strategic planning ensured the successful delivery of the Telescopic Suction Pipe, demonstrating our commitment to meeting client needs under challenging circumstances."





KGE TRANSPORT STEAM BOILERS FROM GERMANY TO KAZAKHSTAN

KGE Baltic were recently nominated to transport four BOSCH steam boilers from Gunzenhauzen, Germany to Zhanatas, Kazakhstan.

The dimensions of each unit measured 8.0 (L) x 3.5 (W) x 3.9 (H) meters with a weight of 44,600 kilograms.

Total transit time for this project was around 35 days including border crossings.

Initially loaded on a low-bed truck in **Germany**, the cargo travelled **overseas via an Italian port**, and then took a southern route through **GE/AZ** by RO-RO on MAFI/low-bed trailers.

Afterwards, the steam boilers were **pre-carried through Azerbaijan** until arrival at the **Port of Kurik, Kazakhstan**. Land transport was utilised hereafter and the cargo was delivered to the final destination in **Zhanatas** - around 4,000 kilometers in-land from KZ Port.

"After a wet season and floodings in the Caspian, we managed to move this cargo when conditions improved."

KGE provided their customer with complete daily tracking, resulting in satisfactory feedback from the client.



3P LOGISTICS SHIP AZIMUTH THRUSTER FROM FINLAND TO CANADA

The **Industrial Projects** department of **3p Logistics** is pleased to share a successful shipment they completed from **Finland** to **Canada**.

On a sunny day in Finland, the company delivered an **azimuth thruster** and its parts to the **Port of Rauma** using lowbed trucks.

After loading aboard an interesting vessel - the **Atlantic Kestrel** - the cargo was shipped **from Rauma to Canada**.

3PL Project Manager **Ilya Goncharov** offered his thoughts:
