SCACLI and Protranster Deliver Heavy Transformers Door-to-Door

PCN members, SCACLI in Canada and Protranster International Logistics in China recently collaborated on the seamless breakbulk shipping of large transformers, each weighing 127mt and measuring 9.1 x 3.1 x 4.45m plus all their accessories. The project was executed via a chartered vessel with final door-to-door delivery.

On the China side, Protranster expertly managed the time-critical specialised transport from the shipper's factory to the port of loading in Qingdao. This included immediate storage at origin, conducting detailed road surveys, and securing necessary permits, ensuring the units departed the factory on schedule. As always, Protranster moved **quickly, securely and professionally** to make this happen.

The initial scope covered transport to the Canadian discharge port. The part charter

was fixed by SCACLI to Canada as well as the discharge. However, just two days prior to the vessel's arrival, the client changed the scope to include final mile logistics. SCACLI coordinated closely with the rail company, truckers, stevedores, and a storage yard for the transformers and parts. Despite numerous challenges - including a rail strike and the need to build a bridge over an existing bridge for the final kilometre from rail siding to the site - SCACLI's dedicated team **ensured a successful execution**.

In addition to the transformers, SCACLI also arranged supporting cargo shipments by air, ocean, and ground from the USA, Canada, Brazil, and other origins.

This project exemplifies **true project logistics excellence** - collaboration with partners and vendors, creative problem-solving, and relentless commitment to delivering results.

EXG Handles Delivery of Passenger Boarding Bridges

Express Global Logistics (EXG) recently demonstrated their exceptional project management capabilities through the successful transportation of critical airport infrastructure components in the western part of India.

Their team managed 40 units of **Passenger Boarding Bridges (PBB)** with a total weight of **235.9mtn**, including oversized components measuring up to **21.16m x 3.68m x 4.2m**.

Their comprehensive services covered every aspect of the logistics chain, including transportation, port handling, and customs clearance.

The complexity of the project demanded sophisticated machinery and the EXG Operations Team deployed 8-axle hydraulic trailers, specifically designed for super-heavy cargo, complemented by two low-bed trailers for optimal load distribution. This equipment selection ensured structural integrity throughout the transportation process.

EXG report that the most challenging aspect involved transporting delicate glass components integrated within the boarding bridge structures. Their engineering team implemented a multi-layered approach with hydraulic suspension systems to minimise road vibrations and heavy-duty cranes with precision controls for loading operations.

“The boarding bridges needed extra care because of being fragile in nature. We solved this by carefully planning the best routes, watching the cargo closely during transport, and using special ways to secure everything. We made sure that minimal z-axis movement happened to avoid jerks that could damage these delicate components.”

Protranster Deliver Cryogenic Ethylene Storage Tank to the USA

PCN members in China, Protranster International Logistics report a recent project involving a **Cryogenic Ethylene Storage Tank to the USA**.

The tank and it’s parts were delivered from **Taicang in China** to **Houston, USA**. The tank measures **18.99 x 3.93 x 4.14m** and **46.8tn**.

The scope of work from Protranster included port services at POL, customs clearance and chartering of the breakbulk vessel for shipping.

The Polaris Project Logistics Team initiated the planning process well in advance, conducting comprehensive feasibility studies, detailed route surveys, and securing all road transport permissions and escorts ahead of the vessel's arrival. Upon arrival at the discharge port, Polaris coordinated a smooth offloading operation, followed by precise inland transportation using specialised heavy-lift equipment. EXG with Successful Transport of 8 Blowdown Tanks

Express Global Logistics (EXG) have recently completed a complex transportation project, moving 8 critical blowdown tanks to the western part of India. The operation showcased the company's expertise in handling oversized industrial cargo with precision and safety.

The 8 blowdown tanks weighed **541.52mt** and each tank measured **17.35 x 6.90 x 7.20m**. They required specialised handling due to their massive dimensions and critical importance to petrochemical operations.

EXG's success stemmed from **comprehensive pre-planning**. The team conducted thorough route surveys, examining every kilometre to identify potential obstacles, measured bridge clearances, assessed road conditions, and determined infrastructure modification requirements. The tanks required 96 hydraulic axles for safe transport, distributing the enormous weight across multiple points to ensure stability and prevent road damage.

The project required **extensive coordination** with highway authorities, electric utilities, and local governments to overcome the complex challenges. EXG managed civil modifications,

toll plaza adjustments, power line shutdowns, and infrastructure adaptations.

Key coordination efforts included:

- Obtaining permits for oversized cargo movement
- Arranging temporary power line shutdowns
- Modifying toll plaza facilities
- Coordinating port loadout operations at the site
