- The export of oversized cargo including pump sets and booms from Cardiff in New South Wales to Jakarta, Indonesia. The cargo was transported using drop-deck trailers and loaded onto 2 x 40'FR and 1 x 40'HC at their Sydney warehouse and shipped via Sydney Port.



Upcargo Logistics Share Latest Multimodal Operations



pcargo Logistics report a successful multimodal operation through Panama's logistics hub.

They recently managed a unique breakbulk ocean shipment that began in the USA with the final destination in the Netherlands and a transshipment planned through Manzanillo, Panama. However, due to vessel delays upon arrival at the Manzanillo terminal, together with their partner in the USA, Upcargo made the strategic decision to interrupt the maritime transit.

Julio Afú, Project Cargo Specialist at Upcargo explains; "The artwork, valued at USD \$550,000, was carefully retrieved from the port, transferred to the airport, and re-routed via airfreight directly to Amsterdam. This ensured our client's commitment to an exhibition deadline was met without compromise.

Thanks to Panama's logistics hub, close collaboration with our US partner, and our team's swift coordination, the cargo arrived right on time - a clear demonstration of flexibility, reliability, and customer focus in action."

EXG Deliver Transformers with Expertise, Safety & Planning

Express Global Logistics (EXG) recently handled a delivery of transformers with expertise, safety, and comprehensive planning.

Every large movement has its own challenges, and this one was no exception. EXG recently undertook the transportation of **three heavy transformers**, weighing a combined **225mt**, from a manufacturing base in Western India to a power project site in the Eastern Himalayan region. The assignment demanded not only **technical accuracy** but also **patience**, **foresight**, **and disciplined execution..**

The transformers were loaded on hydraulic trailers configured into 21 axles in total. This setup ensured that weight was distributed safely, giving the flexibility to adapt to conditions along the way. Before the convoy moved, the EXG team conducted a detailed route study, identifying every possible obstacle, from bridges and tight gates to narrow stretches, plantations, and low-clearance railway crossings. These inspections proved **crucial** once the journey began.

One of the earliest hurdles was a bridge with a much lower load capacity than the cargo demanded. To make the crossing possible, the load was shifted onto a 9-axle configuration, reducing pressure on the structure. Soon after, the first access gate tested manoeuvrability with a sharp turn, which was managed using a 6-axle adjustment. Each decision reflected the balance between equipment capability and on-the-ground expertise.


Railway crossings introduced another layer of complexity. With only 14ft of clearance available, the passage had to be managed with **precise timing and constant communication** between teams on either side. The plantation stretch, nearly 9km long, also brought its own challenges - uneven roads, soft surfaces, and limited space for such heavy trailers. The ground crew reinforced sections of the path where required, ensuring that the cargo advanced steadily. Low-hanging electrical lines were addressed through scheduled shutdowns arranged in advance, eliminating any safety risk.

Further into the route, two river bridges were found unsuitable for the load. The EXG engineers designed and built a temporary bypass strong enough to handle the trailers. This solution, prepared and tested on-site, allowed the cargo to move forward without delay. Later, a second railway crossing with similar clearance issues demanded another round of close coordination with railway authorities to guide the convoy through safely.

Through every stage, safety remained the highest priority. Crowd management measures were put in place to protect local communities, and constant updates were shared with stakeholders to ensure complete transparency. Despite the scale of the cargo and the restrictions of the terrain, the project was executed with accuracy and without incident.

"This was more than the movement of three transformers. It was a demonstration of experience built over decades, of a team that knows how to adapt, and of a company that never compromises on safety or precision. For Express Global Logistics (EXG), every axle that turns represents not just heavy equipment on the road, but a promise of the **reliability and trust** values that have guided us for over 80 years."





CF&S are Powering Estonia's Energy Future

CF&S recently managed the transport of a 115mva transformer from Turkiye to Estonia.

The 127tn main unit and 100tn of parts arrived at **Paldiski South Port** and the cargo was safely discharged using a Liebherr LHM-550 crane, followed by final delivery by road.

Tight port schedules, heavy lift coordination, and oversized road permits required precise planning and teamwork at every stage.



Nonpareil International Freight & Cargo Services in the Philippines are pleased to share a recently accomplished project in collaboration with fellow PCN member, PROLOG India as the chartered vessel provider.

The OOG breakbulk shipment was handled on a hook-to-hook basis from Manila in the Philippines to Chennai, India. The cargo consisted of 6 used metal working press machines with a total gross weight of 179,000kg.

The job scope handled by Nonpareil International included:

- Rigging out of the 6 machines inside the factory plant in Calamba, Laguna;
- Skidding of all machines to the loading area;
- Lifting to multi-axle trucks;
- Set-down, lashing, & securing;
- Transport to Manila Multipurpose Terminal (MMT) at Manila Port;
- · Loading to the chartered vessel at the port.


The pre-operations plan for the implementation of the job scope included site survey at the factory plant for the rigging & skidding, identifying a suitable area for the loading activities, route survey for the transport from factory to port, and permits & clearance.

- Robotic dollies & crawler machines to remotely control the skidding;
- A 110th crane, a 45th crane and 16th forklift for the loading;
- 4 low-bed multi-axle trailers;
- 1 flat-bed;
- Rigging tools and lashing, securing & dunnage materials.

The project cargo operations were completed within 5 days thanks to the **careful planning and process meetings** ensuring a smooth execution. The cargo arrived safely at the port in good time for the chartered vessel's arrival for loading.


