

Ramps Logistics Mobilises Antonov to Deliver Critical Equipment over Christmas

Ramps Logistics report a critical Christmas delivery completed in under 48 hours with innovation and efficiency by mobilising an Antonov AN-124.

"Christmas Eve into Christmas Day is one of the most unforgiving operating windows in logistics. Capacity is scarce, working hours are tight, and timelines collapse fast. But for 24/7 production facilities, the work cannot wait."

During this peak holiday period, Ramps Logistics in Trinidad & Tobago was tasked with an urgent move to support the rapid restoration of full production at a local industrial plant. With freight options limited, the holiday window closing, and cargo positioned across multiple locations, the operation demanded a **decisive solution and flawless execution.**

The answer was an Antonov AN-124.

One of the largest cargo aircraft in the world and a rare arrival into Trinidad, the Antonov was mobilised to meet the challenge. In under 48 hours, the Ramps Logistics team coordinated the consolidation, clearance, security screening, and loadout of critical equipment. Just after 9pm on Christmas Eve, the aircraft entered Trinidad and Tobago's airspace. Before the clock struck Christmas Day, the cargo was on the ground and moving to the site, enabling engineers to begin bringing the facility back online.

*"This operation was executed under pressure at the highest level showing **real-time problem solving** as well as tight coordination across stakeholders, with safety and compliance*

protected at every step. The kind of discipline most people never see, but which many depend on when timing matters most.

Organisations managing critical timelines know that peak-period moves like this are a reminder that the real differentiator isn't speed alone, it's preparedness. When capacity is tight and the margin for error disappears, outcomes depend on partners who can anticipate constraints early, coordinate across all stakeholders, and execute operations safely without losing momentum."





Go Gauge Projects Report Heavy Lift Chartering

Go Gauge Projects have recently successfully executed the chartering of a heavy lift vessel for the shipping of a 200mt piece of industrial machinery, along with additional packages.

The cargo was delivered by Go Gauge under a **door-to-door turnkey solution** from Shanghai, China to Mumbai, India. Their scope of

work included cargo surveys, ground lifting operations, heavy haul transportation, and ocean freight on the heavy lift vessel.

The successful execution was supported by detailed engineering studies, route and lifting analysis, and strict compliance with international safety and operational standards.
